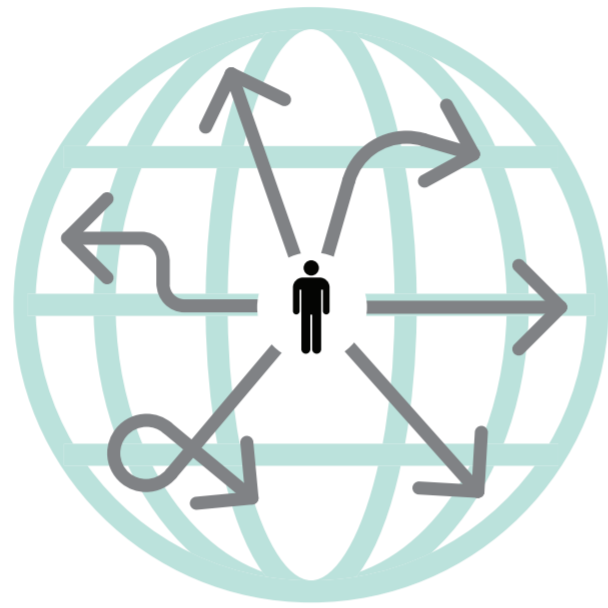

Cycle 1 - Ideate

Research - results:

- The main opportunity to enlarge the network connections are the Coworkers events (MeetUp, OpenCoffees, /dev/haag...)
- These events are a "one-day" chance: everyone is free to participate, people come and go
- Coworkers do not always search for someone different: sometimes they would like to talk to someone that knows about the subject they are working on

- **The interaction needs to be spontaneous and curious, as well as effective and connective**
- **The goal is not to find a perfect match, but someone that has some interesting and useful knowledge to share**

Questionnaire to coworkers - results:

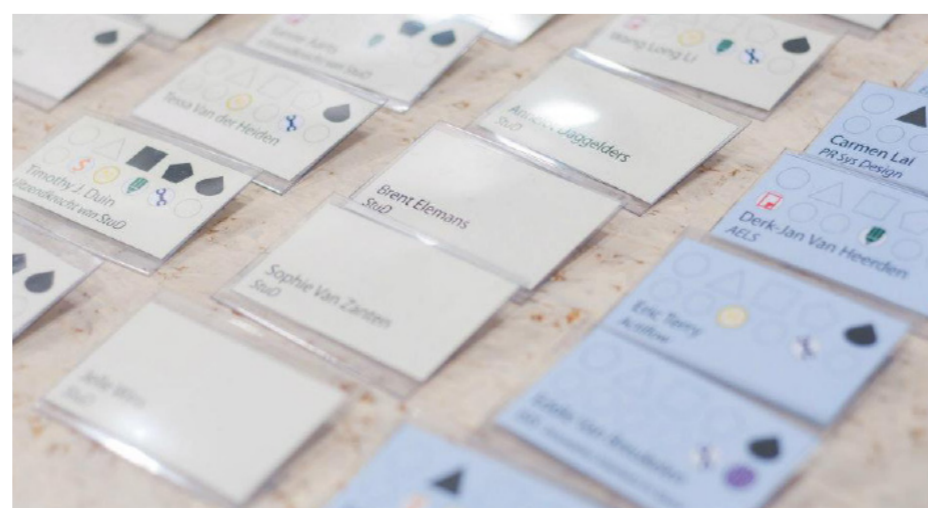
- Users find it easier to describe themselves if some guidelines are provided

Tagging system has to be organized in categories

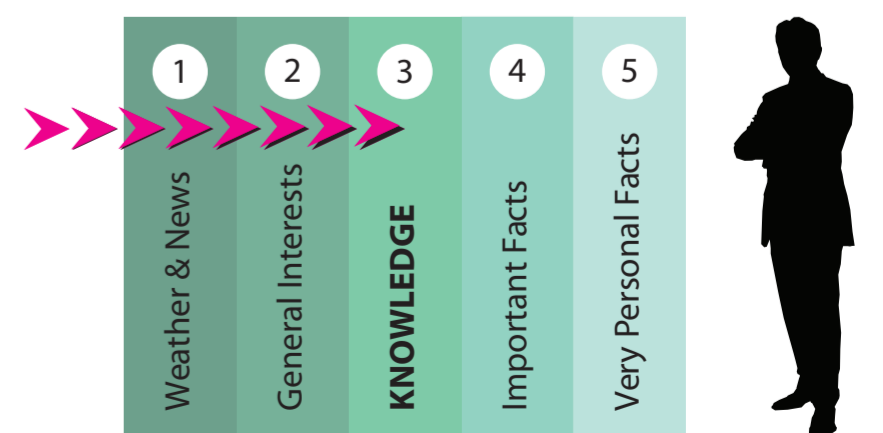
Simulations - feedbacks:

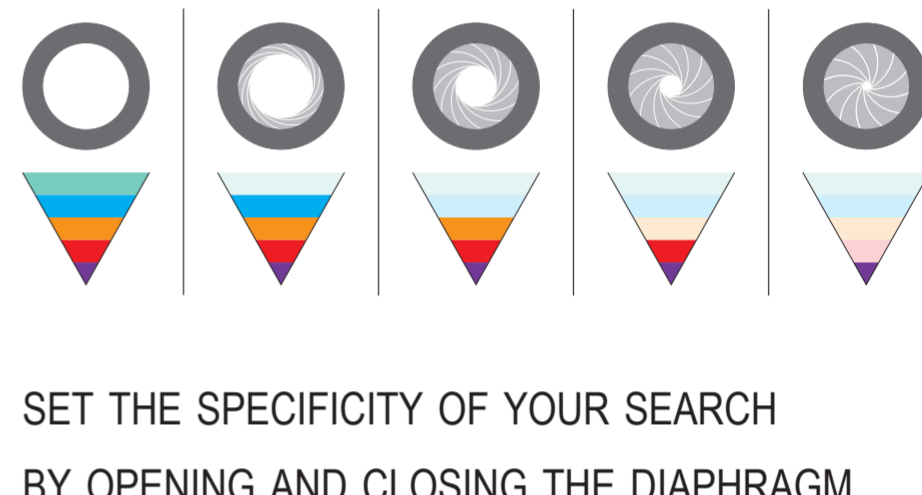
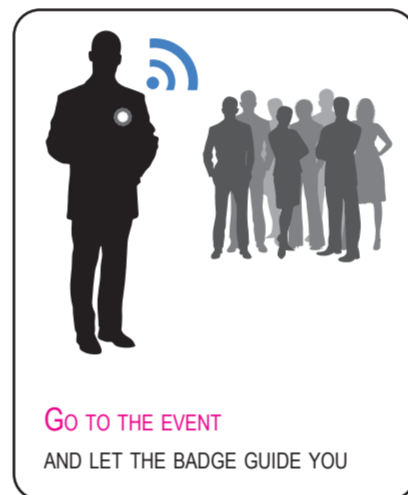
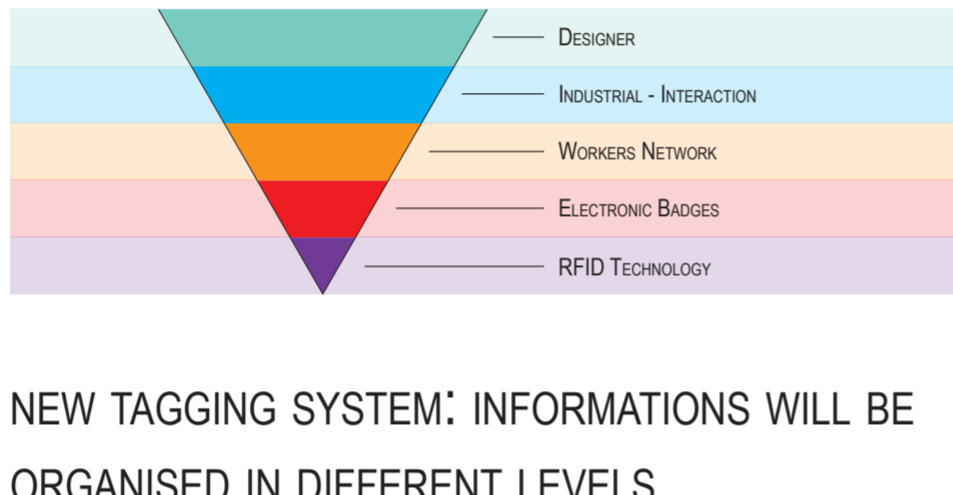


Pikpoke is an electronic badge that will help you to find people to share knowledge with, based on the infos about yourself you registered in it.

Pikpoke will be your wing-man, the one that gives you the hint to start talking to a person that you find interesting, but you don't know how to approach.

Tests & Simulations

Role Play:

- Users had a little car with a small light each + an envelope
- They had to look for people with the same car and try to find which of the words contained in the envelope they had in common

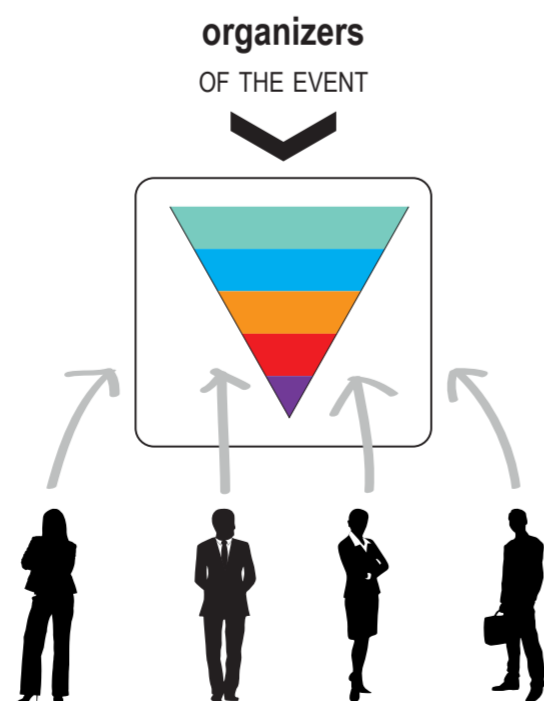
Positive feedbacks: "It works well as an ice-breaker!"



Developments - 1

Research results:

- Users feel more at ease when describing themselves if some guidelines are provided.
- Events for independent workers can be open to everyone, or with specific themes.



The different levels are set for each event by the organizers, the users can adjust their description according to the event.
